SUMMER CLUB

"The summer camp where kids belong!"

(UPDATED 1/25/16)

Camper: Any child who will complete grades K-7 in June 2016. Campers must be registered as 2015-2016 Members of the Martha's Vineyard Boys & Girls Club, in good standing. No child with existing unpaid fees will be permitted to attend Summer Club until account balances are settled in full. Membership Registration is available at the Club and online at www.mvbgclub.org. Annual membership dues are just \$20 per child. Summer Club attendance is limited to 90 campers per day.

What's a Day at Summer Club Like? Each day, campers are split into groups by grade level, or they will have the choice to participate in various special programs. Each morning, camper will rotate through the Club's activity areas, participating in activities lead by members of the incredible Summer Club Staff. Around noontime, all the campers and staff come together for lunch. Afternoons are generally scheduled with beach trips, special events, and fieldtrips, followed by free choice time before camper pick-up.

Summer Club Dates: This year's Summer Club will run as 43 individual drop-in days. No registration is required, other than a MV Boys & Girls Club Membership. Kids can come when they want and/or when you need them to. The first day of Summer Club is scheduled for Monday, June 27th (subject to change dependent on school calendar). The last day of Summer Club will be Friday, August 26th. Summer Club does not operate on Saturdays and Sundays. Summer Club will be closed on Monday, July 4th to recognize Independence Day, and on Friday, August 12th for a special summer fieldtrip to Water Wizz Water Park in Wareham, MA (preregistration and payment is required).

Summer Club Times:

- Campers may enter the program between 8am-12:30pm. No child is permitted to enter the program after 12:30pm.
- Structured camp activities begin at 9:15am and end at 4:00pm daily.
- Normal camper pick-up is between 4-5pm, but campers may be picked-up at any time during the day. Failure to pick-up your by 5pm will result in loss of camp privileges.

Facilities: The Martha's Vineyard Boys & Girls Club's Anthony H. Meyer Clubhouse is located at 44 Robinson Road in Edgartown. With multiple activity areas including an Art Studio, Gymnasium, Games Room, Technology Center, Vegetable/Flower Gardens, and a Picnic Area; the Club is the Island's only exclusive, multipurpose recreation facility for youth. Our location could not be better for outdoor activities, as we are located adjacent to the Edgartown Recreation Area, and just 2 miles from State Beach.

Staff: The Club maintains safe staffing ratios in accordance with Boys & Girls Clubs of America operating standards. All staff members are background checked, complete a staff orientation program, and are CPR/First Aid certified. The staff also includes members who are lifeguard certified.

Fieldtrips & Special Events: Fieldtrips & Special Events will be offered frequently throughout the summer. Some of these trips and events will be camper choice, while others will require that all campers attending camp that day must attend. Some field trips will require an additional fee to be paid and/or the camper to have personal spending money. This summer's fieldtrips are tentatively scheduled to include: Movies at Entertainment Cinemas in Edgartown, Ryan Family Amusements in Oak Bluffs, Mini Golf at Island Cove Adventures in Vineyard Haven, and MV Agricultural Fair in West Tisbury. A special off-island fieldtrip to Water Wizz Water Park in Wareham MA will be available to all Club members, space will be limited and pre-registration will be required. On the day of the Water Wizz trip, the Club facility will be closed as all staff will be on the trip.

Transportation: All campers must have their own transportation to and from Summer Club. The Club contracts bus transportation to transport campers to and from the beach and fieldtrips. Staff members are not permitted to transport campers in their personal vehicles. All campers must be picked-up by 5:00pm.

What To Bring To Summer Club Everyday: Swimwear, Sunscreen, & Towel, Lunch, Liquids and Snacks, and Sneakers for athletic activities. All campers must wear sneakers to participate in gym and athletic activities.

What Not To Bring To Summer Club: Personal Electronics, Toys, Trading Cards, Pets, Boogie Boards, Buckets (we have them), & Beach Chairs. The Club is not responsible or liable for lost, damaged, or stolen items.

Regular Tuition \$30.00 per day (\$150 per week)	Reduced & Free School Lunch Qualifying Student* \$10.00 per day (\$50 per week)
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*Children who qualify for Reduced & Free School Lunch must have their status verified by their school to receive qualifying tuition rates. Without submitting verification, a child will be billed at the Regular Tuition Rate.

Additional Financial Aid: Summer Club is priced to be affordable, not to make a profit. Our goal is to provide the best and safest summer camp experience for children, at the most affordable price for parents. Requests for additional financial aid will be considered on a case by case basis, but there is no guarantee that additional assistance will be issued, or available. To request additional financial aid, please speak directly with the Club's Executive Director.

Additional Fees:

- \$20 Martha's Vineyard Boys & Girls Club Membership Fee (current Club Members have already paid this fee)
- \$10 Bounced Check Fee will be charged for checks returned by the bank for insufficient funds.
- Some fieldtrips may require additional fees, and/or for campers to bring additional spending money.

Payment of Summer Club Fees: All fees are due at the time of child drop-off each day. Parents are encouraged to pre-pay onto their child's account. Any unspent funds are fully refundable, or may remain on account to pay for future program fees. No child carrying a balance of unpaid fees will be admitted to Summer Club.
