Permission to Apply Sunscreen

Name of Camper:

According to the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), sun exposure can cause sunburn, skin aging, eye damage and skin cancer. The sun is especially dangerous during the months of June through August and between the daily times of 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM.

Therefore, I agree to apply sunscreen to my camper before camp, and to send them with extra sunscreen to reapply throughout the day.

In case my camper needs more sunscreen, I give my permission for staff at Martha's Vineyard Boys & Girls Club to apply a sunscreen product of SPF-15 or higher to my child, as specified below.

I understand that sunscreen may be applied to exposed skin, including but not limited to the face, tops of the ears, nose and bare shoulders, arms, and legs.
